LEAP - Laura Bieselin	 Ms. Bieselin was asked by Dr. Beatty to investigate and relay information provided to her re: an 18-month long pilot opportunity, which would begin in Jan 2019 This was an item for discussion on last year's DLT agendas (Nov. 2017 & Jan 2018) Notes from those meetings were shared at this time, including a presentation composed by the former C&I specialist Ms. Beg shared notes from a Dec 2017 phone call with LEAP, including LEAP's reluctance to customize their program for our students. Ms. Beg shared a list of personalized learning tools already utilized by the district Dr. Wennstrom relayed teacher concerns re: implementing personalized learning experiences like LEAP in their classrooms, which were shared last year, including time constraints on PD/training and lack of input in the decision-making process Dr. Wennstrom welcomed feedback re: teacher buy in to a major curriculum change like this Feedback provided: It is clear we're already demonstrating outstanding growth. Therefore, "how would this make us grow more? Is there a connection between something like this and growth?" Feedback was also solicited from two parents present at today's meeting Feedback: Especially for students with special needs, who need that

- extra attention, one more thing online [would not be helpful]
- Dr. Wennstrom shared concern expressed by parents re: too much screen time already
- Dr. Wennstrom is interested in hearing more about coaching through LEAP
 - Ms. Bieselin agreed coaching would be a concept to look into further
- Dr. Wennstrom suggested looking into summer training in order to preserve teacher presence in classrooms due to coverage needs
- After hearing input and feedback from the committee, Ms. Bieselin agreed this was not something to pursue further. She would share the list provided by Ms. Beg of the personalize learning tools we currently have in place with the Board.
