PTO Update

PTO President, Kelly Greco, announced that the Mother/Son dance held last Friday was a great event. Mrs. Greco thanked all the chairs for their efforts and said the kids had a great time. The sport boosters will be hosting their first Face Off event on Friday, November 17th. Junior high students will be facing representatives from the Oak Brook Park District, Fire Department, and Police Department in various sports. On Monday, November 20th there will be a Giordano's Day with 15% of the profits donated to the PTO. The PTO board recognized the district administration and teachers for all the hard work and dedication.

Discussion/Presentations/Committee Reports

District 53 2016-2017 Student Achievement Report

Dr. Wennstrom provided an overview for the board of the Annual Student Achievement and Performance Report for 2016-2017. Dr. Wennstrom noted that the full report would be shared with the staff and on the district website following the meeting. Board members were invited to email any questions or requests for additional data to administration. The report used three assessments: PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers), MAP (Measurement of Academic Progress), and the 5Essentials data. Students, on average in Butler School District started 2-3 grade levels above the national norm in the fall of 2016, based on MAP scores. Butler 53 was one of the highest performing districts in the state based on percentile rank distribution of the state data for grades 3-8 for both ELA and Math. Students attending Butler 53 schools continue to outperform the vast majority of districts in the state, including those attending comparable school districts.

B&G Committee Report

Mr. Paskalides noted that there is an action item for a settlement agreement with Abbey Paving on the summer projects of 2015. The settlement agreement includes a \$58,636.79 credit to the district that results in a zero balance due to Abbey. Mr. Paskalides referred the board to the minutes for additional information of the B& G committee meeting.

School Board Member Day

Dr. Wennstrom noted that along with American Education Week we celebrate School Board Member Day, November 15, 2017. The day gives us an opportunity to recognize the efforts of elected school board members. This is an opportunity to build community awareness and understanding about the essential role locally elected board of education members assume in a representative democracy. This year's School Board Member Day theme is "Leading by Learning." Dr. Wennstrom recognized and thanked the District 53 Board of Education members for their faithful service.

Paul Butler Endowment – 42nd Street

Dr. Martin informed the board of the endowment for the Arts left by Paul Butler. This year 200 tickets for the performance of 42nd Street at Drury Lane on December 10th will be available for the Oak Brook Community at no cost. The tickets will be available for pick up on Monday, December 4th from 9:00 a.m. to 12 noon at the administrative service center.

Strategic Plan Update

Dr. Wennstrom informed the board that the ECRA staff will be in the district on December 4th and 5th for interviews of board members, community members, faculty, staff, parents, current and alumni students, and administrators. Focus group sessions will take place at both Butler Junior High and Brook Forest Elementary. The base plan will be ready for board review in February with final approval in March.

Brook Forest Building Report

Dr. Prosen announced that this week is Bully Prevention Week with great events planned at

Brook Forest.
